How Do I Become a VIBES Volunteer?

- 1) Complete a volunteer application packet (Bellevue School District Volunteer Application, Disclosure Form, and WA State Patrol Form). Be sure to include full contact information for **two** references and a copy of a valid photo ID. You can obtain a volunteer application packet at your school or at the VIBES website: www.bsd405.org/vibes.
- 2) All VIBES volunteers are required to attend a volunteer orientation. The most current orientation flyer with dates, times and driving directions can be found at www.bsd405.org/vibes. **Bring your completed** volunteer application packet to the orientation.
- 3) After you have attended an orientation and your application has been processed, the VIBES Site Liaison for Tillicum, Suzanne Murphy, will contact you to discuss your interests and possible placements. Together you will decide on a day and time to volunteer.
